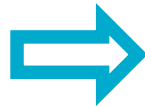

POVERTY/INEQUALITY	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use of food banks has trebled from 2012/3 to 2013/14 (900,000 in 2013/14)• 100 people, that's 0.0002% of the population have more money than the poorest 18Million
DIGITAL EXCLUSION	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1 in 4 adults have never used the internet.• Berner-Lee calls for access to internet to be a human right
LONG TERM CONDITIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 15 million people in UK have long term conditions• Diabetes, arthritis & depression account for 70% of NHS spending
HOUSING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 185,000 affected by homelessness.• House prices vastly outstrip wages.• 10 people chase every home for sale
UNDER-EMPLOYMENT	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1 in 4 people are in PT work• 2.7mil have ZeroHrs contracts
