- Deliver value for money outcome focused services

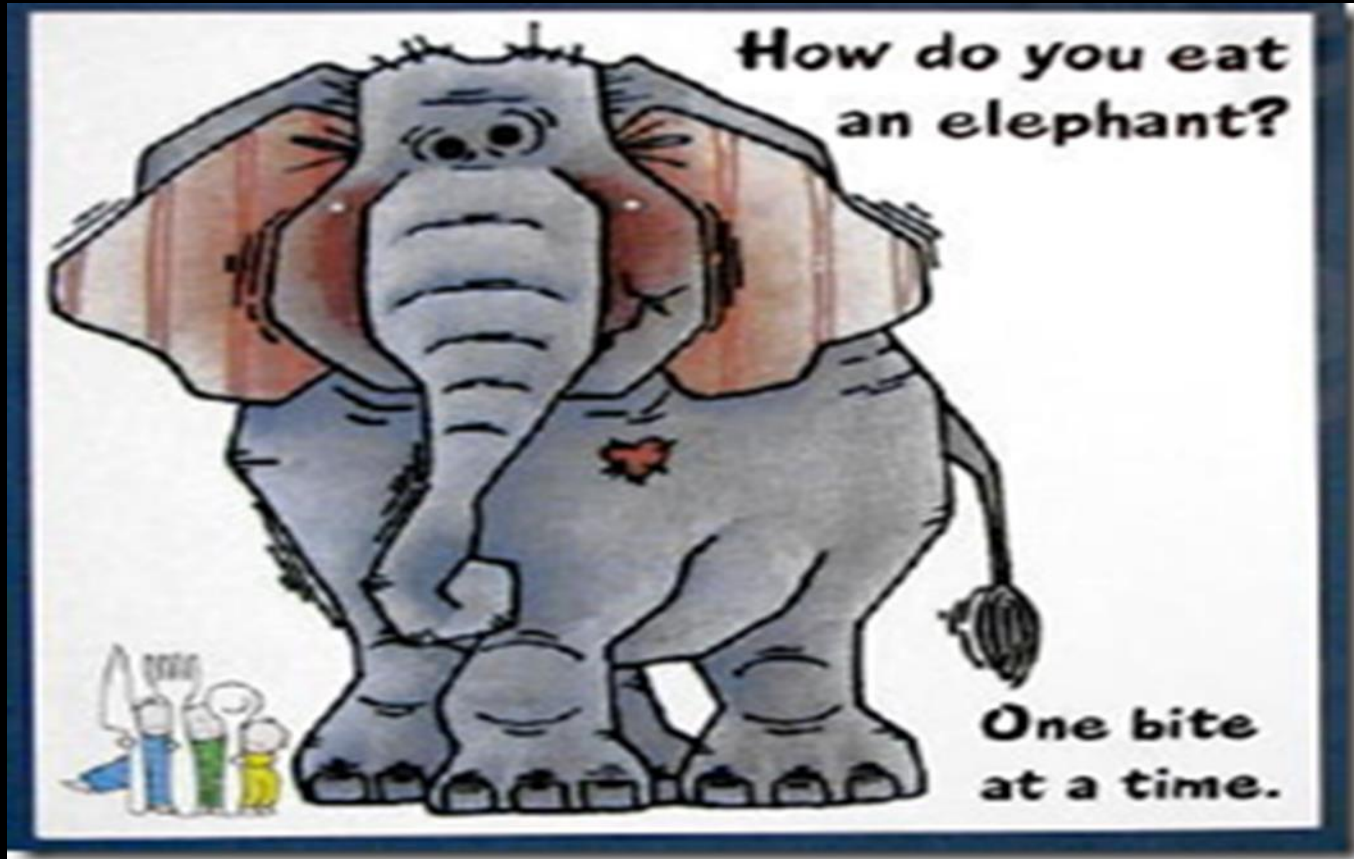
The How.....

- Invitation to Tender published, evaluated and provider interviews held
- Contract awarded to Barnardo's in Nov 2018
